A WORD FROM GOD

Have you heard television evangelists, pastors or ministers, and people on the street with megaphones claim that they have had "a word from God"? Is God talking to them instead of to you or me? How can God talk to anyone, especially since this is the Dispensation of God's Grace? (See **Seed & Bread** No. 57, *The Dispensation of Grace*, by Otis Q. Sellers.)

How can anybody have "a word from God" when the only mediator between God and men and women is the Lord Jesus Christ during this dispensation? "For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus" (1 Tim. 2:5, KJV). (See **Seed & Bread** No. 17, The One Mediator, also by Sellers.)

First of all, God is invisible and inaudible. We can only know God through His Son (expression), Jesus Christ, and we get to know about Christ through the Gospel of John in the Bible (see John 1:1-14 and **Seed & Bread** No. 2, *The Lord Jesus Is Jehovah*). He "talks" to nobody today, though many would like to claim that they have the exclusive "scoop" from God. The only word that God in Christ has left for us is in the Bible—the Old Testament comprised of the Torah, the Psalms and the major and minor prophets, and the New Testament which includes the words of Christ and those of His apostles through the Gospels and Epistles. These together complete the inspired Word of God. "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine (teaching), for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: that the man of God may be perfect (mature), thoroughly furnished unto all good works" (2 Tim. 3:16-17, KJV).

God talks to us through the pages of His Word. In Old Testament times, the Israelites (God's people) had a direct word from God through the prophets and priests. "Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the Scripture is of any private interpretation. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spoke as they were moved by the Holy Ghost" (2 Peter 1:20-21, KJV). During the Acts Period, the Apostles dealt directly with Christ. In the future Kingdom of God, God in Christ will break His silence to judge the world when we are resurrected from the dead. His judgments are His righteous order—they tell us how we have to live if we will be righteous in His sight.

Is there anything too hard for God in Christ? No, there is nothing too hard for God—we all need the truth and a word from God and we have it in the pages of His Word. "God is Spirit and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth" (John 4:24, KJV).

Maybe we get inspiration from just reading God's Word. Maybe we take it on faith that God will help us with everyday problems through the medium of silent prayer. "Be careful (anxious) for nothing; but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving (giving thanks), let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passeth (surpasses) all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus" (Phil. 4:6-7, KJV).

Maybe it is not necessary to have "a word from God" from other sources, like the television evangelists, when God can help us with small problems or large ones, especially when a prayerful request to God is not too selfish and ends with thankfulness for the numerous blessings from God everyday that we live. "Let your moderation be known unto all men. The Lord is at hand" (Phil 4:5, KJV).

We are His children, and just because God in Christ is silent in this day and age, it does not mean that He is not with us. He can be anywhere at anytime because that is how He operates. Nothing is too hard for God.

God in Christ speaks to no one today. He can only speak to us through His Word, the Bible. But in the future Kingdom of God, when God breaks His silence, we will all be able to have a direct word from God.
